I am the Food Security Project Manager of an agriculture and nutrition integrated project whose goal is to improve food availability and access for the poor, HIV/AIDS affected people and female-headed households.

I enjoy working for this project, because instead of responding to today's immediate need of food, WVI's community empowerment approach guarantees sustainability. My courses at AU provided an advantage, enabling me to coordinate and manage all project activities and create adequate strategies in order to respond to community needs in terms of food security from a development perspective rather than disaster mitigation or emergency relief. I teach farmers newer/improved agriculture and livestock techniques and promote adequate and accessible technologies to grow crops and rear livestock for household consumption and for marketing the surplus.

The lives of the people we serve are improving a great deal as a result of these efforts. They no longer face hunger and starvation every year. The situation has improved tremendously and there shall be no need in my immediate area for supplementary food from donor countries.
